Funding for TTI services comes primarily from local county community mental health agencies and authorities under contract with the Michigan Department of Community Health. Funding is also provided by HUD and MSHDA as well as through grants. This funding is generally used for persons with the most severe forms of disabilities who are eligible for Medicaid.

TTI is a private, not-for-profit agency that has been providing mental health services and training in Michigan since 1987. TTI provides a wide range of clinic and community-based services to support adults with behavioral health issues and co-occurring disorders. In addition, TTI provides a full array of services to children with autism spectrum disorders, developmental disabilities and emotional impairments. TTI delivers a wide range of specialty mental health services to include Applied Behavior Analysis, Clubhouse, and Employment Services. TTI accepts Medicaid and private insurances.

Autism Services

Autism Services at TTI

TTI provides Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services for children and adults with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). These services are available at both our Oxford and

Sterling Heights locations.



ABA is an evidence-based practice shown to be effective with individuals with autism. Positive reinforcement and proactive strategies are used to address areas including, but not limited to, the following:

- Language skills
- Social skills
- · Communication skills
- Academic/cognitive skills
- · Following instructions
- · Peer interactions
- Following daily routines
- Self-help and daily living skills
- Behavior challenges

ABA services are designed and supervised by experienced and dedicated Qualified Behavior Health Professionals (QBHP)/Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA), implemented by bachelor level behavior technicians and supported by senior level behaviorists.

ABA therapy begins with a comprehensive array of standardized behavioral assessments. These assessments provide the foundation of the individual's behavior intervention plan. This plan focuses on target areas to include communication, socialization and adaptive behaviors; ultimately to improve one's overall quality of life. ABA services may take place within the clinic, community and/or home, and are based upon each individual's unique strengths and identified needs.
