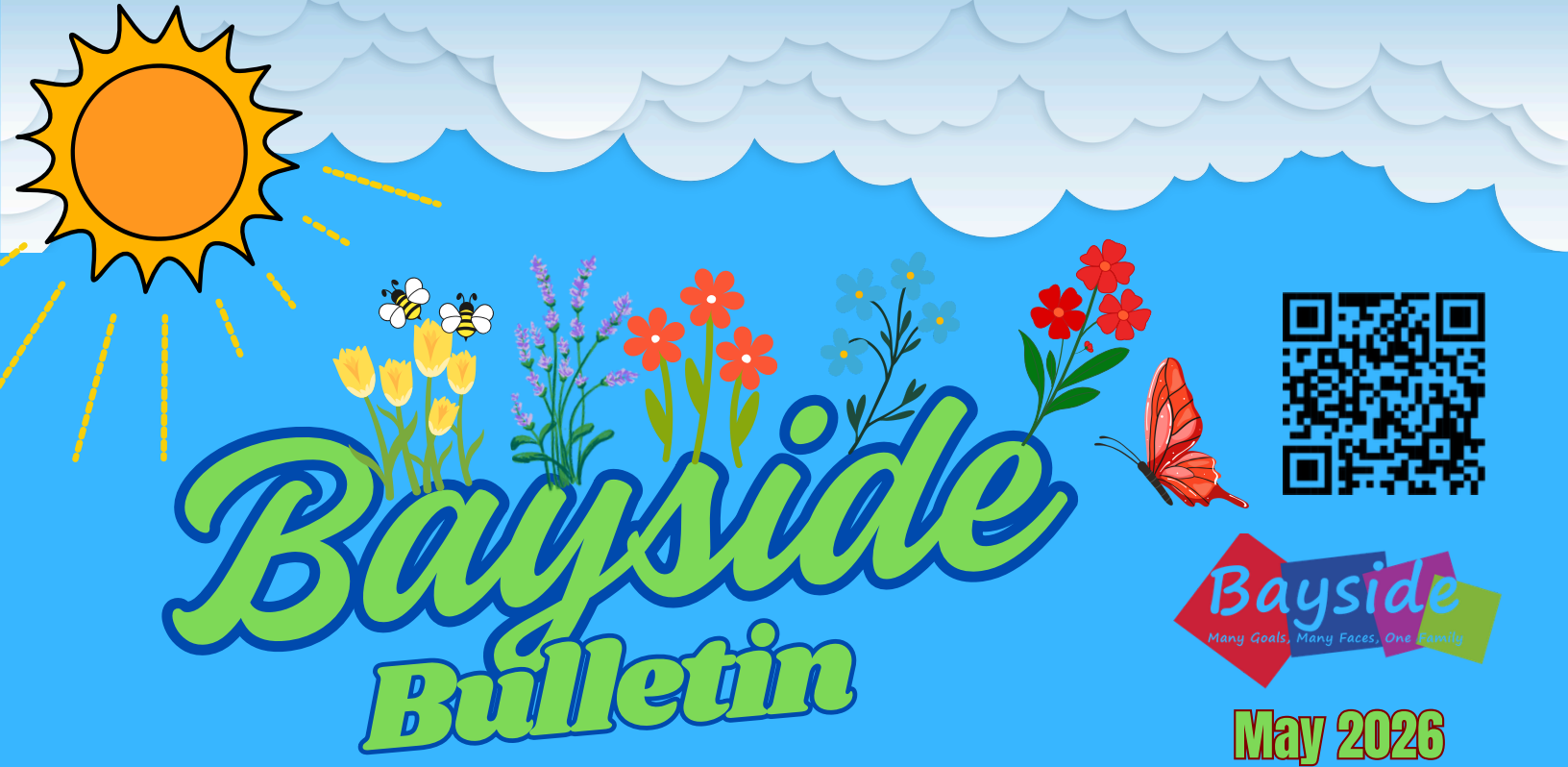
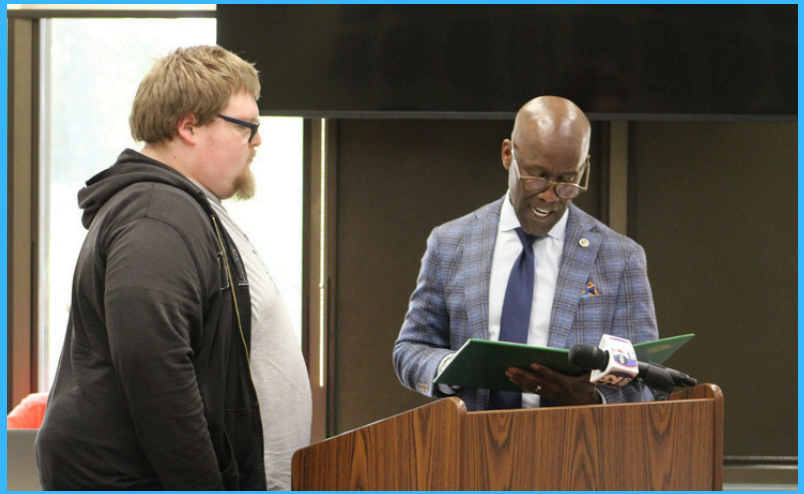




Proclamations

On May 6th, Bayside director Jim Nesbit and a few members went to the Andersen Enrichment Center to support Saginaw County Community Mental Health Authority accepting the proclamation from the Saginaw City Council.
